Data presented on this webpage has been developed from many sources during the course of contaminant investigations, research projects, graduate and post graduate studies, and professional papers contracted by Federal and State government agencies and the phosphate mining industry. Data collection in all cases occurred under the oversight or direction of the participants involved in development of this webpage. Site investigation data collected under legal agreements and data collected under contract to the phosphate mining industry was collected according to the protocols specified by the National Contingency Plan and State of Idaho regulations. Studies and data collection conducted by university professionals, government researchers, and other scientists were performed under guidelines and peer reviewed procedures generally accepted by the scientific community.
